### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the program's programmatic approach supports the Government of Indonesia's energy sector reform priorities and represents a sustained partnership between ADB, the government, and other development partners. Subprogram 3 supports the transformation of Indonesia's energy sector through reforms initiated in 2014, which aim to (i) improve fiscal sustainability and governance, (ii) expand private investment, and (iii) promote the deployment of clean and efficient energy options. Subprogram 3 supports the government's ambitious energy sector reforms under the National Medium-Term Development Plan (RPJMN) 2020-2024 and its greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reductions of 29% under its nationally determined contribution.
