Project Description

This proposed TA also effectively builds on a past ADB-financed TA which supported the PRC in developing recommendations for a national framework for soil pollution and contaminated land management. Lessons from this TA can potentially be replicated in other priority remediation sites not only in the PRC but also in other developing member countries facing similar challenges.

The TA project will have three outputs: (i) technical guidelines, operational standards, and recommendations for cost-effective technologies and contaminated farmland remediation projects; (ii) strategies for sustainable financing for remediation activities; and (iii) knowledge of key stakeholders on contaminated farmland remediation.

Quality of arable land for rice farming in Hunan Province improved.
