The impact and outcome of the overall project will remain unchanged from the ongoing project. The construction and provision of furniture and equipment will be added to Output 1 of the ongoing project: Gap in enrollment capacity of schools and kindergartens narrowed, but the remaining outputs will remain unchanged.
