Subproject 1 involves recommending a set of services to be pilot tested to demonstrate e-government capabilities. It will involve the recruitment of an international ICT architect, a sector specialist, and legal consultants, preferably through a firm, to deliver the feasibility report. The project team will work closely with ADB and government counterparts to execute day-to-day tasks."
