Project Description

According to the bank document, Government of the People's Republic of China requested technical assistance (TA) from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to support the formulation of a strategy that will simultaneously control air pollution and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in the transport sector. The TA will help the Ministry of Transport (MOT) develop a (i) draft guideline on evaluating the co-benefits of policies and measures, and (ii) a strategy for the collaborative control of air pollution and GHG emissions, for consideration by the PRC government. The TA is included in ADB's country operations business plan, 2017–2019 for the PRC.

The TA is aligned with the following impact: the objectives of controlling air pollution and GHG emissions in the PRC's transport sector in 2025 achieved. The TA will have the following outcome: policies on controlling air pollution and GHG emissions in the PRC's transport sector improved.
