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## **Project Description**

According to the Bank's website, this project provides technical assistance for the preparation and implementation of a related project aimed at expanding renewable energy production and infrastructure in Mongolia. Outputs of the overall project include:

1. Connecting the western and Altai Uliastai grid systems to the national grid systems, to strengthen energy transmission.
2. Piloting pumped storage hydropower generation schemes, including Kherlen-Choir (50MW).
3. Piloting geothermal heat and power generation schemes, including in the Khangai mountain area.
4. Deploying advanced heating technologies to reduce the use of coal.
