### Project Description

ADB is providing 0.5 million USD with a purpose of technical assistance which will help the government of the Republic of Kazakhstan prepare the project on Livestock Value Chain Development. Livestock numbers are projected to continue to increase over the period 2019-2022, reflecting the government's aim of increased national self-sufficiency. Women and men are evenly represented in agriculture, however, the number of women employed in agriculture has declined by 34% between 2006 and 2016. The government regards improving the population's access to livestock products as a means of improving standards of human nutrition and food security.

### Project Objectives

Technical Assistance will help with:

- (i) preparation of the project feasibility study (including all required due diligence),
- (ii) relevant costs related to project processing by ADB and the government,
- (iii) implementation start-up support.
