### **Project Description**

According to the bank document, ADB will engage the consultants following the ADB Procurement Policy (2017, as amended from time to time) and its associated project administration instructions and/or staff instructions. ADB will recruit a consulting firm using the quality and cost-based selection method with a quality-cost ratio of 90:10 under an output-based contract.

The Consulting firm will manage an interdisciplinary team of international experts (64 person-months) and national experts (51 person-months). ADB will monitor and evaluate the TA based on the implementation of activities and satisfactory delivery of outputs following the agreed timeline and budget.
