Investments will support the (i) upgrading and renovation of health facilities and equipment and workforce development in three provincial and two district hospitals; (ii) delivery of a comprehensive program of workplace, community-based, and facility-based programs services for female and male migrant workers and border area communities; and (iii) rollout of an electronic medical record (EMR) and unique health identifier UHI) to strengthen continuity of care between border area health facilities.
