### Project Description

According to the bank document, "the knowledge and support technical assistance (TA) will support the Asian Development Bank (ADB) implement Strategy 2030 (S2030) by institutionalizing differentiated approaches in context-sensitive situations. Context-sensitive situations is a broader definition of the fragile and conflict-affected situations (FCAS) framework adopted by ADB in 2010.

The TA will

- (i) review and update the context-sensitive framework and the Operational Plan for Enhancing ADB's Effectiveness in Fragile and Conflict-Affected Situations;
- (ii) enhance implementation support in context-sensitive situations; and
- (iii) strengthen analytics, knowledge and innovation.

Through these, ADB is expected to assist DMCs to progress along the continuum from context-sensitive situations, to transition, to stable and then resilient situations."
