### Project Description

According to the bank's website, "a proposed grant of \$1 million from the APDFR is expected to fund expenses necessary to restore life-sustaining services, including but not limited to: (i) provision of medical kits, food, and bottled drinking water; (ii) purchase of water purification and sanitation systems; (iii) provision of transitional shelter; (iv) provision of personal hygiene kits; (v) site cleaning; and (vi) safe disposal of useless rubble. The proposed grant will contribute about 3% of the currently identified funding needed for the emergency response."
