Project Description

According to ADB website, the proposed grant aims to support the Government of Nepal (the government) to improve selected local governments' capacity to better response to coronavirus diseases (COVID-19) pandemic through community-level interventions. The grant supports the provision of essential public services and Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) supplies to block interpersonal transmission of COVID-19 in public spaces, behavior-cantered community mitigation measures to contain the pandemic and manage panic and misinformation, and the strengthening of Department of Water Supply and Sewage Management (DWSSM), 5 municipalities, and 10 small towns' capacity to timely respond to COVID-19 and other public health emergencies.
