Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the technical assistance (TA) will help the government prepare the ensuing project to meet both ADB and government's requirements. The TA will (i) conduct feasibility study for commercial agriculture development (CAD) component; (ii) prepare or update due diligence assessments for the proposed project, including updates of technical, environmental, social, gender, economic, financial management, and climate change assessment; and preparation of strategic procurement planning document, and gender equality and social inclusion action plan; (iii) update the water balance study updates; and (iv) provide implementation start-up support. The TA is included in the indicative pipeline during the country programming mission conducted in May 2024.
