In particular, there are growing hopes that the recent advent of generative AI can lift productivity growth and promote inclusive and sustainable development. The outputs are the following: (1) assessment of DMCs' readiness for AI adoption conducted; (2) analysis of AI's contribution to economic growth and development prepared; and (3) policy recommendations and knowledge sharing promoted.
