Project Description

According to the ADB, the project consists of a US\$15mn or MNT equivalent loan to PN, to support (i) the expansion of a cold chain distribution center supporting its CU convenience store chain and (ii) the establishment of new stores in and outside Ulaanbaatar including in rural areas.
