Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the proposed technical assistance (TA) will finance project preparatory activities for at least five additional health sector pipeline projects in the Pacific region. The TA will also support the identification and development of potential future pipeline projects, and support ongoing ADB health sector operations across all fourteen Pacific developing member countries (DMCs).

Pacific DMCs are increasingly seeking the support of Asian Development Bank (ADB) to strengthen their respective health systems to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC), particularly in prevention, preparedness, response, and recovery post-pandemic. The TA will support ADB to assess and prioritize health sector investments to be considered under country pipelines, enhance the readiness and effectiveness of health sector investments under processing across Pacific DMCs, enable ADB to promote and implement innovative health interventions in the Pacific, such as in digital health, health security, and workforce development, and addresses the region's requirements for knowledge enhancement and capacity building within the health sector.
