## Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the Project aims to support access to finance, export enhancement, job creation and preservation for exporters, specifically those in earthquake-affected provinces of Turkiye, focusing on enterprises which are women-inclusive through the financing of longer-term loans by financial intermediary: Eximbank (Strategy 2030).



## Investment Description

- Asian Development Bank (ADB)

The financing amount is \$585,150,000, which will be financed on a loan basis by ADB's ordinary capital resources.

## Financial Intermediary

Financial Intermediary: A commercial bank or financial institution that receives funds from a development bank. A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares. Financial intermediaries include insurance, pension and equity funds. The direct financial relationship is between the development bank and the financial intermediary.

*Türk Eximbank* (Export Credit Bank of Türkiye) is the official export credit agency (ECA) of the Turkish government, founded in 1987 to support foreign trade and international contractors/investors. It is 100% owned by the Ministry of Treasury and Finance and acts as a key instrument in Turkey's sustainable export strategy.
