Project Description

As stated by the ADB, the project consists of an equity investment of up to (i) \$75 million in TPG GSI, and (ii) \$25 million in a TPG GSI co-investment sleeve. TPG GSI is a regional private equity fund targeting a total fund size of \$1 billion. TPG GSI forms part of TPG's broader strategy to deploy up to \$2.5 billion in climate-focused investments across India, Southeast Asia, Africa, and Latin America. TPG GSI aims to provide primarily growth capital investments in companies operating in five key sub-sectors: (i) energy solutions, (ii) green mobility, (iii) sustainable fuels, (iv) sustainable materials and products, and (v) carbon solutions.

Financial Intermediary

A financial intermediary then lends these funds to their clients (private actors) in the form of loans, bonds, guarantees and equity shares.
