### **Project Description**

According to the Bank's website, the technical assistance (TA) will support Mongolia's ongoing tax reform initiatives, which aim to promote investment, create jobs, and support small and medium-sized enterprises by balancing taxpayer rights and reducing compliance costs. The reforms completed under the TA - strengthened policy formulation, enhanced data analytics, improved coordination, and stronger international cooperation—will help boost economic growth, increase domestic revenue mobilization, encourage environmental sustainability, and foster gender equality. The TA aligns with the Government of Mongolia's Vision 2050, which aims for stability in state tax policy and legislation, as well as the creation of a favorable environment to protect and attract investment.

### Investment Description

- Asian Development Bank (ADB)

The TA financing amount is \$2,500,000, which will be financed on a grant basis by ADB's Technical Assistance Special Fund (\$2,000,000 from TASF 8 debt management set aside and \$500,000 from TASF 8). The government will provide counterpart support in the form of counterpart staff, office accommodation, office supplies, secretarial assistance, and other in-kind contributions.
