Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the technical assistance (TA) will support the Ministry of Labor and Employment (MOLE) in strengthening India's labor market and social security systems to enhance worker protection, well-being, and employability. The TA will provide support in three areas: (i) policy analysis and recommendations to improve labor market and social security schemes, (ii) technical analysis and strategy to enhance operations, analytics, and digital integration of systems, and (iii) capacity building for key stakeholders on policy development and implementation.

The TA is aligned with the Government of India's vision of building a strong labor market and social security system for workers, ensuring their safety, well-being, and growth in India's evolving employment landscape. The Union Budget 2025 highlighted critical initiatives for boosting employment such as the Prime Minister Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana and expanding social security coverage for new forms of work. By strengthening the policy, institutional, and digital foundations, the TA will help MOLE develop the tools and strategies needed for long-term reforms and investment in labor market and social security systems.
