### **Project Description**

According to the Bank's website, this small-scale knowledge and support technical assistance (TA), 'Catalyzing Innovation and Strengthening Project Readiness and Implementation, will provide a flexible \$225,000 grant-funded mechanism to deepen ADB's engagement with Turkmenistan under the CPS 20242028 and support the government's goals for a more diversified, competitive, and innovation-driven economy. The TA will strengthen responsiveness to increasing government requests by financing early-stage programming, knowledge products, and high-level dialogue, including support for pipeline development, private sector research, policy advice, and WTO accession efforts. It will also facilitate workshops, policy dialogues, and capacity-building activities, helping advance priority initiatives such as railway modernization, nursing sector development, NSO engagement, and climate and trade-related reforms. Aligned with Strategy 2030 (OP6), the TA will improve ADB's agility, visibility, and strategic impact in Turkmenistan, laying the groundwork for future sovereign and nonsovereign operations.
