The project leverages the comparative advantage of Asian Development Bank (ADB) as a multilateral development bank (MDB) with experience supporting countries in delivering on their commitments to multilateral environmental agreements, mobilizing development finance, and translating country commitments into investable projects. The project is focused away from logistical support, rather to support the government to deliver an inclusive, knowledge-driven, and sustainable COP17. The TA is designed to ensure that Armenia's hosting of COP17 contributes to building institutional capacity, developing policy dialogue, and creating the environment for future biodiversity-positive investments.
