Project Description

According to bank's website, this RRCP (the project) aims to establish a pre-arranged crisis preparedness and contingent financing mechanism under the Asian Development Bank's (ADB's Rapid Resource Reprogramming and Deployment Option (3RDO). It is designed to strengthen readiness and enable the rapid deployment of repurposed sovereign portfolio resources following eligible crises. The project will support immediate response and early recovery activities following disasters and emergencies, including those caused by economic crises, through existing government systems and agreed activation procedures. The project will provide a framework for the rapid financing of emergency livelihood support, emergency supplies and equipment, and emergency repairs and rehabilitation. It will be integrated into Vanuatu's existing national disaster risk management (DRM) system, complement available disaster risk financing (DRF) instruments, and strengthen institutional readiness throughout the project lifetime.
