According to bank documents, the main goal of the program is to promote a sustainable, competitive and diversified electricity sector for ensuring security of supply and supporting climate change mitigation and green growth. The expected outcomes of the program are: i) rationalization of the electricity tariff; ii) enhanced financial sustainability of the electricity sector; iii) improved corporate governance and competitiveness of the key electricity sector institutions; iv) enhanced security of energy supply through promotion of renewable energy and energy efficiency for fostering climate change mitigation and green growth; and v) stronger engagement of the private sector for better service delivery.
