According to AfDB website, the Ethiopia COVID-19 Crisis Response Budget Support (ECRBS) program, is to support the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia's NERP to contain the spread of COVID-19 and to mitigate the economic and social impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on local businesses and vulnerable households, particularly the urban poor. The operational policy objectives of the program are: (i) increased social protection coverage to mitigate the impact of the pandemic on the most vulnerable; (ii) enhanced capacity to contain COVID-19 pandemic; and (iii) addressing macro-fiscal imbalances and mitigating the effects of the crisis on the private sector.
