The development outcomes include enhancing the Fund's effectiveness in the following areas: a) supporting the continued mobilization of longer-term private sector capital towards infrastructure development; b) increasing infrastructure service penetration and hence the quality of life of the citizens; and c) increasing the corporate tax revenues from the taxable income deriving from the Fund's investees.
