According to the Bank's website, the project's development objective is to improve the living conditions and climatic resilience of poor and vulnerable urban populations in three districts of the city of Niamey and in the Tillabery region. To this end, the project is structured around three components: (i) immediate priority interventions to extend/rehabilitate the water supply network and strengthen resilient sanitation facilities in the city of Niamey, (ii) preparation studies for an investment project in the Tillabery region and the development of tools for integrating climate resilience into WATSAN, (iii) capacity building and project management.
