### Project Description

According to AfDB website, the project aims to support the Government of Rwanda's (GoR) Coronavirus 2019 National Preparedness and Response Plan (NPRP) and Economic Recovery Plan (ERP) May 2020 to December 2021, which outlines measures to contain COVID-19; mitigate the economic and social impacts of the pandemic on local businesses and vulnerable households; and contribute to the mitigation of macroeconomic risks. The expected outcomes of the program are: (i) enhanced capacity of public health system to contain COVID-19;(ii) vulnerable households' livelihood protected and (iii) risk to macroeconomic stability minimized and private sector's resilience enhanced.
