## Project Description

As stated by the AfDB, the project development objective is to improve agricultural productivity in EAC Partner States by strengthening extension systems through innovative private sector led approaches and conducive policy environment. Specifically, it aims to (i) promote a regional approach to strengthening agriculture extension, (ii) enhance the role of digital extension in transforming agriculture, (iii) facilitate farmers' access to advice and information, (iv) facilitate adoption of climate-smart technologies and build resilience of farming communities, and (v) create job opportunities for young people, particularly in rural areas.

The project aims to benefit 5 million direct and indirect beneficiaries in EAC Partner States through improvements in agricultural extension systems reaching 3,000,000 farmers (50% women) in 4 years.
