### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, this project provides financing for the rehabilitation and modernisation of a section of International Road A380 (km 150 - km 228). This will be comprised of 5 components:

- rehabilitation, modernisation and widening of about 78km of International Road A380
- construction supervision of implementation of component (i)
- preparation of contracts documentation and associated tender documents for approximately an additional 160km of International Road M37
- institutional strengthening and capacity building
- equipment purchase for quality control involving modern technologies and methods of construction

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### ACCOUNTABILITY MECHANISM OF AIIB

The AIIB has established the Accountability Mechanism for Project-Affected People (PPM). The PPM provides “an opportunity for an independent and impartial review of submissions from Project-affected people who believe they have been or are likely to be adversely affected by AIIB’s failure to implement the ESP in situations when their concerns cannot be addressed satisfactorily through Project level GRMs or AIIB Management processes.” Two or more project-affected people can file a complaint. Under the current AIIB policy, when the bank co-finances a project with another development bank, it may apply the other bank's standards.
