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## **Project Description**

According to the Bank's website, the objective of the project is to (i) increase the electricity supply in the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam by supporting a cross-border electricity trade, and (ii) assist Lao PDR's diversification of its energy mix.

The project involves the development, construction, and operation of an approximately 600-megawatt wind generation facility, an associated 500-kilovolt substation, and a 500-kilovolt transmission line in Sekong Province and Attapeu Province in Lao PDR. The generated electricity is expected to be sold to Vietnam Electricity (EVN).

Two or more project-affected people can file a complaint. Under the current AIIB policy, when the bank co-finances a project with another development bank, it may apply the other bank's standards.
