Project Description

Objectives

To provide safe, efficient, and climate-resilient connectivity along the Atyrau-Dossor Section of the A-27 Highway in Kazakhstan's Atyrau Oblast.

DESCRIPTION

The Project will upgrade 86 km of the A-27 Highway between Atyrau and Dossor from two to four lanes to boost capacity, safety, and climate resilience. It includes building a dual carriageway with bridges, overpasses, culverts, an interchange, and rest areas, along with supervision and capacity-building components.

As part of a broader regional connectivity initiative, the road connects major international corridors, facilitating trade across western Kazakhstan and access to the Caspian port of Aktau. The Project will also pilot a Design-Build-Maintain contract and introduce Atyrau Oblast's first toll road to enhance long-term performance and financial sustainability.

AIIB will cover about 88% of the cost through two tranches in 2025–2026, with the remaining financing provided by the Government of Kazakhstan.
