According to the Project Summary:

The expected outcomes of the project are: a reliable and climate resilient supply of potable water to residents and businesses in the north of St. Lucia; and (b) enhanced management and operational capacity in WASCO in the areas of gender inclusion, climate resilience planning, and financial management. The proposed project consists of the following components:

**(a) Project preparation studies;**

**(b) Land acquisition;**

**(c) Infrastructure works comprising:**

- (i) Sediment removal and disposal;
- (ii) Repairs to spillway and the John Compton Dam access road;
- (iii) Development of supplementary water intakes; and
- (iv) Installation of dam monitoring instrumentation.

**(d) Capacity building of WASCO comprising:**

- (i) Gender Capacity Building in the Water Sector;
- (ii) Climate Vulnerability Assessment and preparation of an adaptation plan;
- (iii) Capacity building in the Finance Department;

**(e) Tete Chemin Rainwater Harvesting Initiative;**

**(f) Watershed Restoration Works;**

**(g) Project management; and**

**(h) Engineering services.**
