According to bank documents, Fund II is a proposed \$90 million private equity fund that will make growth equity investments, primarily in SMEs, in the Palestinian territories. The fund will invest in 12 to 15 businesses in vital sectors of the local economy, such as healthcare, financial services, agriculture and infrastructure.
