DFC will finance a collateralized loan obligation ("CLO") securitization of loans originated, underwritten, and serviced by responsAbility Investments AG that will provide downstream loans to approximately 35 microfinance and small and medium enterprise financial institutions in approximately 18 DFC-eligible countries to expand their microfinance and small business lending portfolios.
