Project Description

As stated by the DFC, the project consists of the development, construction and operation of a 200-megawatt solar photovoltaic power plant near the city of Manta in the Manabí province of Ecuador.

The Project is expected to have a positive development impact in Ecuador through the development of 200 MW of solar photovoltaic capacity, which is expected to generate 344 GWh of energy annually. The additional energy supply will help address Ecuador's growing energy needs and support the diversification of Ecuador's electricity generation, which is currently highly consolidated around hydropower with most of the remaining generation from fossil fuels. The Project also represents the first large-scale solar power project in Ecuador, demonstrating the financial and operational viability of solar projects in the country.
