Project Description

According to the Bank's website, Avaana Sustainability Fund is a \$130 million venture fund that invests in technology-based companies that enable climate solutions and sustainability. The Fund invests in startups in the following sectors: 1) energy and resource management, 2) e-mobility and related supply chains, and 3) sustainable agriculture value chain and responsible consumption.

The Fund seeks to have a positive development impact in India by providing much needed capital to innovative early-stage companies that use new and existing technologies to address climate change. The Fund plans to invest in concepts that address inefficiencies in high carbon-emitting activities in the region, including energy and resource management, mobility and supply chains, and food and consumption.
