Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the fund invests in water, sanitation and plastic recycling SMEs globally, primarily in Africa. The Project is expected to have a positive development impact by directing capital and capacity-building to SMEs which are addressing water poverty, inadequate sanitation, and plastic waste, primarily in sub-Saharan Africa.



Early Warning System Project Analysis

DFC debt investments into Investment Funds who will support investments into SMEs are screened as a Financial Intermediary C (FI-C) for environmental and social assessment. These downstream investments are expected to result in minimal adverse environmental and social impacts. Therefore, all those downstream investments have been pre-screened as low risk and further review and consent is not required for these investments.
