According to the Bank's website, this project finances technical cooperation to support the establishment of a comprehensive contact centre where businesses and citizens will be able to report irregularities in industry practices in order to suppress the existing grey economy that is currently present in Serbia. Additionally, this project will support the establishment of a Book of Inspection Practices that will enable learning from experience for further improvement of overall inspections oversight.

Specifically, this will require: (i) engagement of operations, expert associates and web administrators to perform activities that would enable Contact centre and the Book of Inspections Practice to be a valid tool; and (ii) promotion of the contact centre to inform and stimulate business entities and citizens to report irregularities
