Project Description

According to the bank website, the project consists of a loan to be extended to RED Union Fenosa Moldova S.A. (UFM), the electricity distributor covering Chisinau as well as southern and central Moldova. UFM is 94 percent owned by Union Fenosa Internacional S.A. and 6 percent by the EBRD.

The EBRD loan will be used to upgrade UFM's network through investments in distribution lines as well as improvements in substations, installations, and information systems.

The Project Complaint Mechanism (PCM) is the independent complaint mechanism and fact-finding body for people who have been or are likely to be adversely affected by an European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD)-financed project. If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
