## Project Description

According to EBRD website, the project will be financing the construction of a new passenger terminal at Tivat Airport, extension of the manoeuvring area and rehabilitation and extension of the runway to achieve compliance with the International Civil Aviation Organisation's safety standards. It will address this issue by increasing handling capacity of the passenger terminal and adding aircraft stands that would provide sufficient capacity for the next ten years and improve service quality.

Technical Cooperation assignments linked to the project are expected to include an Energy Efficiency Audit, to be funded under Sustainable Transport Technical Assistance Programme.
