The loan will be provided to ArcelorMittal S.A. and will then be on-lent to the group's Ukrainian subsidiary PubJSC ArcelorMittal Kryvyi Rih, a public joint stock company majority owned by the borrower (95.13 per cent) and established in Kryvyi Rih, Ukraine.
