Project Description

This project will finance natural gas supply infrastructure construction and connection for the city of Taldykorgan, Almaty Oblast. The infrastructure will connect 17.9 thousand households, or 40% of the city's population, to gas networks.

The long-term plan involves construction of sub-main gas networks in the remaining districts of Taldykorgan.



Investment Description

- European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD)

The EBRD is providing long-term financing in the form of a senior loan to Zhetysu-OblGas, a special purpose component of the Oblast Akimat.

The project is co-financed by Almaty Oblast Akimat.
