According to the Bank's website, this project provides financing to the joint municipal enterprise Water Supply and Wastewater Management Agency of the Uzgen Region for the rehabilitation of urgent water supply works in the municipalities of Myrzaki, Kurshab and Don-Bulak. This includes replacing water supply networks, rehabilitating water supply systems, and modernizing household metering and operational equipment.

The Company has 12,180 registered customers as of 2018, forecasted to grow to 33,461 by 2022 and 43,045 by 2033 as a result of the investment project and the annual population growth.
