CMI owns and operates a fleet of marine vessels employed in the Caspian Sea which provide maritime logistic support and services, including to offshore oil developers in the region, however, CMI or its vessels are not directly involved in the exploration, extraction or transportation of oil or gas. CMI is an existing client of EBRD through the previous project signed in 2011.
