Project Description

This project provides senior loans to private (and in exceptional cases public) companies to finance the construction and operation of renewable energy projects in Kazakhstan. These include solar, wind, small hydropower, and biogas energy sources, as well as the modernization and strengthening of the electricity grid.

The EBRD expects to finance 6-9 projects under this project during the next 5 years. The sponsors will be local private institutional and public investors, as well as international private and institutional investors.
