### Project Description

A senior loan to XacBank ("XB") for up to USD 10 million under the Financial Intermediary Framework ("FIF") for financing private micro, small and medium-sized enterprises ("MSME") in Mongolia. Subject to market conditions, the Bank will try to raise an additional amount of up to USD 30 million for the account of participants.

The operation will enable XB to continue to provide funding to MSME in Mongolia when access to finance has deteriorated due to difficult overall market conditions.

If you submit a complaint to the PCM, it may assess compliance with EBRD's own policies and procedures to prevent harm to the environment or communities or it may assist you in resolving the problem that led to the complaint through a dialogue with those implementing the project. Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
