### **Project Description**

This proposal involves sovereign loan of up to EUR 131 million to the Government of Egypt to finance the drain infrastructure rehabilitation component of the integrated depollution programme of the Kitchener Drain, the main agricultural drain passing through the governorates of Kafr El Sheikh, Gharbeya and Dekheila in the Delta region.

The proposed loan is expected to finance:

- 1. drain rehabilitation works (dredging of canals, and rehabilitation and construction of new pumping stations);
- 2. diversion works of the Omar Bek sub basin; and
- 3. installation of a monitoring system for water flow and quality (the "Project").
