Project Description

According to the Bank's website, this project finances the construction of a twin pipe tunnel in Kobija Glave and connection road to the tunnel (on the 1st Transversal road); and a dual carriage way at the end of the Sarajevo bypass road (on the 9th Transversal road).

Land acquisition, predominantly of privately-owned land, will be carried out on the 1st Transversal road and 13 temporary commercial structures on municipal land on the 9th Transversal road will be affected, which will result in some physical and economic displacement.

The technical cooperation associated with this project includes: (i) a resettlement framework for the Canton; (ii) technical, economic and environmental due diligence; and (iii) advanced procurement support.
