## Project Description

According to EBRD website, the project will finance the construction of approximately 14 km long section of Corridor Vc to full motorway standard with dual carriageway. The section starts with a bridge over River Bosnia just south of the Rudanka interchange in Republika Srpska (RS) in the north and continues southbound, bypassing the town of Dobož, towards the FBiH via Usora to Medakovo.
